The lands of Reguengos de Monsaraz are rich in reasons to visit and to contemplate.

From the landscapes, once of a typical Alentejo, now enriched with the extension of water from Alqueva, to the monumentality of Monsaraz, "sentinel of the Guadiana, guarding the border with Castile" through the vast archaeological field of these lands, populated with traces with chronologies from Prehistory to the Contemporary Age.

These same lands of Reguengos de Monsaraz are equally rich in vineyards that stretch as far as the eye can see and that, as in Torga's poem, we gaze in awe at their immensity, a naked body, in fire or chilled that has the face of serenity.

It is here, in this mix of history, calm and serenity, in an enviable terroir, where is born the wine that has given the name to the county, overflowing beyond the sea to reach all corners of the world.

Wine Tourism allows the visitor to know the symbiosis of the world of history, visits and contemplation, with the experience of tasting wine together with the explanations of the details of its production, made by those who know how to do it. It gives the visitor the experience of breathing the atmosphere of the cellars, of the barrels, of feeling the wine closer, in its development process.

The wine-growing region of Reguengos de Monsaraz includes 11 wineries, 10 of which offer wine tourism activities to their visitors.

The document we present here has a double purpose. It is an invitation to visit the different wine tourism sites in Reguengos de Monsaraz and to benefit from the various experiences that they provide. It is, simultaneously, an informative guide to the many options available to the visitor on his trip to our lands, which we are grateful for and wish to be an unforgettable experience.

ADEGA DO CALISTO





Located in the northern part of the city of Reguengos de Monsaraz, Quinta da Várzea was planted with century-old vineyards when the Calisto family acquired it in the early 1980s. The production from these vineyards has always been vinified in Reguengos de Monsaraz, first in private wineries in the city and then in the local cooperative.

The Calisto family, a couple and their daughters, launched the exclusive processing of their grapes and the marketing of their wines when they built a winery from scratch in 2004, able to process and store the production of Quinta da Várzea.

The excellence and diversity of red grape varieties such as Trincadeira, Aragonez, Alicante Bouschet, Touriga Nacional, Touriga Franca, Syrah and Cabernet Sauvignon, or white grape varieties such as Roupeiro (Síria), Rabo D'Ovelha, Perrum, Alvarinho, Antão Vaz and Sauvignon Blanc, as well as the accuracy and care taken since planting, allowed the production of wines Callistus White and Red - DOC Reguengos, Adega do Calisto - Regional Alentejano and Joaquim Calisto - Reserve and Special Harvest.

Adega José de Sousa (José de Sousa Winery) is located in the center of Reguengos de Monsaraz. Those who visit this wine producer can taste its Alentejo wines from brands such as José de Sousa, José de Sousa Reserva, José de Sousa Mayor, the top of the range J de José de Sousa and Puro Talha White and Red, as well as the brands Montado, Monte da Ribeira, among others.

Founded in 1878, Adega José de Sousa is a unique winery in the world and one of the oldest and most traditional in the Alentejo, with an exceptional collection of 114 talhas, some of which still being used to produce the famous talha wine, keeping alive a tradition started by the Romans more than 2,000 years ago. Below ground level, besides the traditional cellar with the talhas and two wine presses for treading, the visitor will also get to know the modern winery, with 44 stainless steel tanks and all the indispensable technology for the vinification of reds, rosés, and whites.

All this makes it the ideal place to witness the combination of innovation and tradition and thus get to know a little more about exceptional wines. If looking for wine tourism programs in this region, this is a recommended place to go for the opportunity to visit a unique winery in the world and taste wines made with this ancient technique.

CARMIM - Cooperativa Agrícola de Reguengos de Monsaraz was created in 1971 by a group of 60 winegrowers and currently has about 700 members, owners of more than 3,000 hectares, producing wines and olive oils with the care and respect that the legacy of the ancestors demands.

In a region where wine production dates back to the Roman domination of the Iberian Peninsula, tradition and innovation produce wines full of character and typicity. The richness and diversity of soils, from schistose to granitic, but with a predominance clayey soils, together with the conditions of a long and dry summer, make the territory an eternal allied of renowned grape varieties that, together, mark the profile of CARMIM wines. An experienced enology that knows the territory, innovative and aware of tradition, are the guarantee of wines that consumer has been used to respect over the decades.

Casa de Sabicos is a family project with origins in the 19th century. The pioneering vision of Grandma "Sabica", who introduced the vineyard in her vast farm in Alentejo, inspired throughout five generations of the family the taste for production of quality wines.

Ahead of its time, it rewarded excellence through an annual competition of wines produced by himself and his eight children in the nine wineries she built

With character and "Alentejana" soul, Casa de Sabicos wines are created from traditional grape varieties, with grapes from the Family vineyards that cover several farms with different terroirs, taking advantage of different soils and microclimates

The wines are the result of a combined fermentation of grapes, which gives them a distinctive character, and in years of exceptional maturation, some are produced in very small quantities. The labels of all the wines are created from original watercolors by the great-granddaughter of Grandma "Sabica".

Elite Vinhos is located near the medieval village of Monsaraz, one of the oldest towns in Portugal, surrounded by vineyards and olive groves. It is a family-owned company, proud to produce wines from native grape varieties planted in its 110 hectares of vineyards perfectly adapted to the local conditions.

The company gives high importance to all interventions in the annual vineyard cycle, from the first pruning to the harvest, limiting the use of pesticides and using all existing resources to maximize sustainability. With this philosophy of strong connection to the origins and maximum respect for nature, they intend to make wines with unique identity and style.

Its philosophy of quality and respect for the ecosystem also applies to the winery, which vinifies the grapes using the best of traditional practices and modern technologies. During the winemaking process, temperature control is used, but other than that, the winemaking interventions are minimal, as Elite Vinhos wants its wines to be true expressions of the grape varieties and the terroir.

Ervideira dates back to 1880 consequence of the title received by José Perdigão Rosado de Carvalho - "Count of Ervideira". Currently, Ervideira's average annual production is around 600,000 bottles of wine, obtained exclusively from grapes harvested from its 110 hectares of vineyards divided into two sites: one in Vidigueira (60 ha) and one in Reguengos de Monsaraz (50 ha).

Combining tradition and revolution, Ervideira creates each wine with its own personality. Centuries pass by and history repeats itself, for Ervideira is intended to be a simple company, where life is sinuous, but of tremendous beauty. It was with this irreverent spirit that Ervideira became a pioneer in the region and has one of the most differentiated portfolios in the world of wines. In this way and with the unique characteristics of Alentejo, Ervideira turns Alentejo's wines into a mystical and incomparable beverage. In a territory with more than 750 years, about 170km southeast of Lisbon, near the historic town of Reguengos de Monsaraz, right in the heart of the Alentejo, one of the most important wine and olive oil producers in Portugal was born. Between gentle plains and shallow valleys, carved by intermittent streams, cereal fields, vineyards and certified organic olive groves, Herdade do Esporão hides in its history the art of knowing how to make the most of the rich history, and a unique ampelografic field.

At Herdade do Esporão, since 1997, the tourism restaurant opens to the outside and presents "terroir" cuisine, with zero waste, modern cooking and interpretation, centered on the product – from Alentejo, Portuguese and at the rhythm of the seasons, with products from the Herdade's biological gardens and from local and national producers. Chef Carlos Teixeira is the one at the head of this restaurant that, in 2022, was awarded with a Michelin Star and a Green Michelin Star.

Esporão was born in Alentejo with the will to make the best products that nature provides. Over the years, it has expanded to the Douro region, with Quinta dos Murças, to Vinho Verde, with Quinta do Ameal, and to craft beer, with Sovina.

It was home of Damião de Goes (XV century), having remained in the possession of his descendants until the beginning of the 20th century. Later, Monte dos Perdigões was the residence of Luís de Freitas Branco, an illustrious composer and leading figure of contemporary Portuguese culture. The musician, certainly inspired by the gentleness of the landscape, wrote many of his most remarkable works.

Perdigões wines try to present to the consumer the most faithful image of the conditions in which they are produced, related to the climate, soil and grape varieties planted there. The technology used in the winery seeks to combine traditional methods with the most advanced technology, always with the objective of respecting the grape and its characteristics.

São Lourenço do Barrocal



São Lourenço do Barrocal wines are made with extreme care from grapes produced within the 780 hectares of this estate, which is also a luxury hotel. Following a fully certified organic method, these high quality wines carry on the cycle of self-sustainability that has been present on this farm since its foundation in 1820. This is something that represents the innovative impulse of its founder, Manuel Mendes Papança, whose pioneering vision led to the creation of the winegrowing community of Monsaraz and the region as a demarcated area.

It is in a climate typical from Alentejo, but with great influence of Alqueva Lake, that these grapes grow, always from the granite and clay soils punctuated by Monsaraz schist. This combination allows the vines to create deep roots for greater resilience and robustness. All this gives the grapes great freshness and acidity, characteristics carried to the range of wines that go from reds to rosés, whites, talha and sparkling wines, all by the renowned winemaker Susana Esteban. Winegrowing occurs in an entirely closed cycle, always within the estate and without any artificial irrigation - it is a dryland culture. São Lourenço do Barrocal wines also pay tribute to a 200 years old family legacy, always respecting the cycles of nature, open to the world, but with roots firmly planted in this warm land, in its history and culture.
